B.Sc. IN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

Eligibilty for Admission to B.Sc. (I.T.)

Student from the following categories will be eligible for admission:

1) A candidate for being eligible for admission to the degree course of Bachelor of Science Information Technology, shall have passes XII standard examination of Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent with Mathematics as one of the subject and should have secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate for Open Category and 40% marks in aggregate in case of Reserved category candidates.

- 2) Candidate who have passed Diploma in Computer Engineering / Computer Science / Computer Technology / Information Technology / Electrical, Electronics & Video Engineering and Applied Branches / Mathematical and Applied Branches Civil and Applied Branches of Engineering after S.S.C. (Xth Standard) are eligible for direct admission to the second year of B.Sc. I.T. Degree course.
 - However, Diploma should be recognized by the Board of Technical Education or any other Recognized Government Body. Minimum marks required 45% aggregate for Open Category and 40% marks in aggregate in case of Reserved category candidates.
- 3) Candidates with post HSC Diploma in Computer Engineering / Computer Science Computer Technology / Information Technology and applied branches will be direct admission to the Second year of B.Sc. (I.T.). However, the Diploma should be recognized Government Body Minimum Marks required 45% aggregate for Open Category candidates and 40% for Reserved Category candidates.

Duration of Course:

The course is full time with six semester spread over three year. It consists of 30 papers with sixth semester specially designed for project work.

All such students will have to obtain an Eligibility Certificate from the Divisional Secretary, Maharashtra State Board of Secondary Education, Mumbai, Sector 16, Vashi, Navi Mumbai and submit the same to the college office for final admission with in 10 days from the date of admission otherwise admission will be cancelled.
- A student who has passed S.S.C. or equivalent Examination from other than Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, and not opted for ENGLISH IN THE SAME WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION.
- 4) Admission will be purely on the Merit Basis.
- 5) Donation: The College or the Management does not accept any donation for admission. We give admission as per standard and transparent norms.
- 6) All the admission process for F.Y.J.C. (Std. XI) will take place as per rules laid by Maharashtra State Government Education Department. Student has to compulsory fill the online admission form before seeking admission in college.
- 7) A student passing Std. X examination from other than Maharashtra State Board should submit mark sheet, passing certificate, transfer certificate with counter signature and migration certificate with in ten days of admission (counter no. 8)

B) Documents required along with Application for Admission

For all admissions, application should be made through prescribed application form, which is available in the college office. The application form should be duly filled and it must reach to the Principal within the stipulated period as notified. The application form must accompany following documents.

- 1) Original Marksheet of the previous qualifying examination along with two Xerox copies attested by the competent authority.
- 2) No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the Principal of the college last attended. (This is applicable only to the students of other college (Non bonafide students)
- 3) School Leaving certificate in original with two Xerox copies attested by the competent authority.
- 4) Eligibility Certificate (Provisional/Final) in original.
- Attested Xerox copy of Caste certificate, if admission is being sought for reserved category.

- 7) Original copies along with one Xerox copy in case of any other reserved category such as Freedom fighters, Government Job Transfers, Ex-Servicemen, Handicapped etc.
- 8) Character Certificate in Original (Applicable only to the students migrating from other college)
- For reserved category students, only Maharashtra Government Caste Certificate is valid.

C) Status of Admission

- 2) No admission will be valid unless it is granted by the authority of the Principal.

D) Cancellation of Admission

X DISCIPLINE AND CODE OF CONDUCT

If any student breaks college/University rules or shows any violent or aggressive behavior or desire to harm others will be liable for strict disciplinary action.
