## Findings:

- **Students:** The analysis report related to the aggregate feedback on the curriculum shows that, approximate 80% students have a positive attitude towards the current curriculum. A majority of students agree that the syllabus is excellent and express satisfaction with the syllabus designed by the Board of Studies of University of Mumbai.
- **Teachers:** Teachers are satisfied with the syllabus framed by the Board of Studies (BOS) at the University of Mumbai. More than 70% teachers gave positive feedback for current curriculum. They have proposed minor revisions to improve the existing syllabus. Some subject teachers feel that certain topics are too broad and difficult to complete within the given hours and allotted number of lectures.
- **Alumni:** College alumni are comfortable with and satisfied by the curriculum designed by the University of Mumbai. The feedback analysis report of alumni shows that more than 90% former students believe that the knowledge gained from this curriculum helps them compete globally and that the soft skills they acquired have been beneficial.
- **Employer:** Employers are impressed by their employee's subject knowledge, professional appearance, and soft skills. Approximate 80% employers are pleased with their employee's performance.

## Suggestions:

The IQAC conducted meetings with department heads and senior staff to review student feedback on the curriculum. This feedback system helps teachers pinpoint areas where the curriculum is strong and where it needs improvement. Based on this feedback, the **College Management, Principal, and HOD/ Senior Most Persons** have recommended some recommendations for changes.

### Suggestions:

- ❖ The department should deliberate with the Board of Studies to discuss student feedback on the current curriculum.
- ❖ The subject teachers are encouraged to participate in workshops focusing on the syllabus and practical hands-on sessions.
- ❖ The subject teachers should enroll in training programs such as Short Term Courses, Refresher Courses and Orientation Courses to learn about new teaching methods and strategies.
- ❖ The department should organize workshops to address the Revised Syllabus.
- ❖ The department should organize National/International Seminar/Conference on syllabus oriented topics.
- ❖ The Subject teachers should provide guidance through mentoring, including advice on the curriculum and career counselling.
- ❖ The department should organize the Curricular and Co-Curricular Activities.
- ❖ The subject teacher should incorporate ICT tools such as Google Classrooms, Google Slides, Google Docs and MS Power Point, in their teaching to enhance effectiveness.


